PORT OF VANCOUVER USA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING Tuesday, March 11, 2025

CALL TO ORDER

Commission President Burkman called a regular meeting of the Port of Vancouver Board of Commissioners to order and open to the public at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at the Port of Vancouver USA Administrative Office, 3103 NW Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington 98660.

OPENING REMARKS

Commissioner Burkman welcomed everyone to the commission meeting. He announced that no executive session was held and noted the meeting is being recorded. He also informed attendees that Commissioner LaBrant will not be in attendance. Commissioner Burkman stated that the meeting is being conducted in a hybrid format, allowing both in-person and virtual participation via Zoom for those wishing to provide oral comments. On motion by Commissioner Orange, seconded by Commissioner Burkman, and carried 2-0, the Board of Commissioners approve the minutes of the February 25, 2025, regular meeting.

ACTION ITEMS

E-1 Approve Sixth Amendment and Extension to Second Supplemental Master Lease Agreement between the Port of Vancouver USA and Northwest Packing Company

Chrissy Lyons, Director of Industrial Business presented the action item and discussed it with the Commission.

On motion by Commissioner Orange, seconded by Commissioner Burkman, and carried

2-0, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to sign the Sixth Amendment and Extension to Second Supplemental Master Lease Agreement at 1701 W 16th Street between the Port of Vancouver USA and Northwest Packing Company.

E-2 Approve Public Works Contract for Bid 25-03: Berth 7 Maintenance

Greg Westrand, Senior Project Manager presented the action item and discussed it with the Commission.

On motion by Commissioner Orange, seconded by Commissioner Burkman, and carried 2-0, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to execute a public works contract with Advanced American Construction, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for Bid 25-03: Berth 7 Maintenance, in the amount of \$3,901,900.00 plus applicable Washington State sales tax.

SUBJECT:	Approve Public Works	Contract for Bid 24-58: Building 330	00 Office Build

BACKGROUND:

This project supports the port's Strategic Plan goal to pursue opportunities that utilize the port's property and infrastructure investments to create jobs and support the economy.

The Board of Commissioners approved a Lease Agreement between 360 Sheetmetal LLC and the Port of Vancouver USA effective June 1, 2024. Due to Building 3300 being demised for 2 tenants, this portion of the building needed facilities to accommodate both operations. The Lease Agreement included the port designing, permitting and constructing of office space and mezzanine storage. If approved, this project will construct 5,000 sf of general office space to include private offices, server room, conference rooms, breakroom, restroom facilities and 3,000sf of mezzanine storage. The construction schedule for this project is 130 working days. Once ready for occupancy, 360 Sheetmetal LLC will complete their move into the port's Centennial Industrial Building.

On February 20, 2025, the Port of Vancouver issued an Invitation to Bid 24-58: Building 3300 Office Build.
