Commission President LaBrant called a regular meeting of the Port of Vancouver Board of Commissioners to order and open to the public at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at the Port of Vancouver USA Administrative Office, 3103 NW Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington 98660.

BACKGROUND:

This project supports the port's strategic plan goal of protecting air quality, water resources and land managed by the port through deliberate and proactive efforts in all aspects of the port's operations.

This project is a maintenance activity which removes sediment from one of the port's primary stormwater management facilities at Terminal 4. Specifically, this contract relates to transport and disposal of sediment at an approved and regulated off-site facility. Work will occur this year with an approximate completion date of October 1, 2024.

On May 6, 2024, the port issued Invitation to Bid 24 -24: Terminal 4 Pond Solids Trucking project. On May 23, 2024, the following bids were received:

Taylor Transport Inc.	Vancouver, WA	\$404,537.92

NW Construction General Contracting	Battle Ground, WA	\$592,832.41

Staff has reviewed Taylor Transport Inc.'s responsive bid and concluded they are a responsible contractor capable of performing the work.

The engineer's estimate is \$523,250 - \$578,400. The project is included in the approved 2024 budget.
