PORT OF VANCOUVER USA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING Tuesday, August 22, 2023

CALL TO ORDER

Commission President Orange called a regular meeting of the Port of Vancouver Board of Commissioners to order and open to the public at 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, August 22, 2023, at the Port of Vancouver USA Administrative Office, 3103 NW Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington 98660.

OPENING REMARKS

E-1 Approve Public Works Contract for Bid 23-28: Terminal 4 Stormwater Pond Solids Removal Project

Mark Newell, Project Delivery Manager presented the action item and discussed it with the commission. He answered questions from the Board. On motion by Commissioner LaBrant, seconded by Commissioner Burkman and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to execute a public works contract with Swofford Excavating, LLC, the lowest

responsive and responsible bidder, for Bid 23-28: Terminal 4 Stormwater Pond Solids Removal Project in the amount of \$636,560.17 including Washington Sales Tax.

E-2 Approve Public Works Contract for Bid 23-24: 2023 Maintenance Dredging Project

Mark Newell, Project Delivery Manager presented the action item and discussed it with the commission. He answered questions from the Board. On motion by Commissioner Burkman, seconded by Commissioner LaBrant and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners authorize the CEO to execute a public works contract with HME Construction, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for Bid 23-24: 2023 Maintenance Dredging Project in the amount of \$908,298.85 including Washington State sales tax.
