Expectations for staying safe at the Port of Vancouver



SPEED

Please drive safely to and from the port
Trucks and vehicle speeds on the terminal

- 25 mph on designated roadways
- 15 mph in cargo laydown and construction areas



TERMINAL TRAFFIC SIGNS

- Trucks and vehicles are required to obey all traffic signs



YIELD


Trucks and vehicles yield right-of-way to

- All cargo handling equipment
- Pedestrians
- Oncoming traffic



USE TRAVEL ROUTES AND LANES

- Report unsafe conditions to Security Main Gate 360-992-1120



LIGHTS ON FOR SAFETY

- Vehicle lights must be on when inside the terminal



STAY CLEAR OF WORKING VESSELS AND CRANES

- Watch for moving equipment and cargo



BE AWARE OF ACTIVITY ON THE TERMINAL

Cargo and equipment move constantly

- Obey speed limits
- Be aware of equipment and pedestrian movement




NO IDLING

- Turn off engine while waiting or before exiting the vehicle



WEAR SAFETY VEST AND HARD HAT AT ALL TIMES



USE CAUTION ON AND AROUND TRAIN TRACKS

- Never enter a railroad corridor without proper training and prior authorization
- Coordinate ALL rail corridor activity with port rail EIC 360.518.0076



STOP, LOOK AND LISTEN AT ALL RAILROAD CROSSINGS

- Watch for moving equipment and cargo
